# Community Service Worker Program

## Program Objectives

This program provides students with the basic knowledge, skills, and work experience needed to become permanently employable in a CSW setting. Skill development is delivered in three

- ◆ Comprehensive community service worker knowledge, including psychology, sociology, family life, mental health, addictions, criminology, at-risk populations, case management, counseling, ethics, business communication, report writing, and government and social services
- ◆ Full range of computer and office skills, including current software applications, keyboarding skills, and personal and professional development
- ◆ On-site work experience through participation in a 160 hour placement at an approved CSW facility

## Duties and Responsibilities

Community Service Workers may be involved with any (and in some cases with all) of the following duties and responsibilities:

- ◆ Organization at the community level
- ◆ Social planning
- ◆ Urban planning
- ◆ Management of human services
- ◆ Development of communities and programs
- ◆ Program expansion
- ◆ Policy analysis
- ◆ Policy change
- ◆ Advocating for people or groups
- ◆ Mediation
